

Bondage Breaker Cell Group Discussion Questions

6 Week Course

Week 2 Chapters 4-6

1. If you were to rate your mind on a scale of 1-10, 1 being "at rest" and 10 being "restless"; where would you fall? Where would you like to be? How is finding your mind at rest related to the influences and distractions of your life?
2. On Page 60 Neil Anderson describes 7 strongholds of self defense. Which of these apply to your life and how do they keep you from the truth. What fears keep you in the mode of self defense?
3. In 2 Corinthians 11:3 Paul describes how he is fearful that the enemy is leading their minds (thoughts, desires) away from the purity of their devotion to Christ. What things distract your mind? How is it possible to 'hold every thought captive for Christ?'
4. Describe the difference of the Brain and the Mind as Anderson speaks of in chapter 4. How are we reliant on God to help us break free from the strongholds of the mind so that we can be renewed by the transforming of our minds (Romans 12: 1,2)
5. In Chapter Five, Confronting the Rebel Prince, we are called to recognize our ability to live in obedience to how we understand and relate to Authority. In what ways do you struggle with authority? How do we allow evil to rule in our hearts? How do we take authority over that influence?
6. In order to be free to minister in the Authority that Christ has given you ; how can you strengthen your: Belief, Humility, Boldness, and Dependence on God? (pages 85-88) How do those things free you to live? How do they express the Authority of Christ that reigns in you? How can fear wash out the fire of those four characteristics?
7. How does God protect you? Why is it so important to put on the FULL armor of God? When you are dressed in a way that makes you feel confident and proud how is that similar to being dressed in the armor of God? What things do you do that leave you exposed?: (ie... forgetting one piece of armor or another).
8. Why is it important that we engage in the spiritual battle of binding the strong man? How will people be able to hear, accept and follow the Gospel if the enemy has confused, blocked and bound them from hearing? Who will you pray for this week to be released from the power of the enemy?
